Here is a list of a few supplies that is asked of each kindergarten family to purchase for the 2024-2025 school year. <u>Please bring these items on the first day of school.</u>

Please purchase and bring in the following required items:

- Backpack (regular sized) -label with child's name
- Lunch box-label with child's name
- 1 reusable, leak-proof Water Bottle *-label with child's name*(instead of water fountains)
- 1 plastic 5"x8" Crayon/Supply Box -label with child's name
- 2 packs of 24-count Crayola Washable Crayons
- 8 Elmer's Washable Glue Sticks (or more would be appreciated!)
- 1 pair of blunt-tipped, metal child-sized Scissors -label with child's name
- 1 pack of yellow Ticonderoga #2 pencils, regular size
- 1 black, chisel tip (thick) Expo dry erase marker
- 1 yellow, chisel tip (thick) highlighter
- box(es) tissues

Please bring only the above supplies.

Other supplies such as folders, markers, colored pencils, etc. will be supplied as needed.
